### Article 3. - EVENT DETAILS

- 3.1 The Motorsport Australia MRF Tyres South Australian Rally Championship (hereafter referred to as the Championship) will be Special Stage Rallies using A to A timing - event type (c); as per National Rally Code NRC EG 1.2. Held under the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the National Competition Rules of Motorsport Australia, the National Rally Code, the current South Australian Conditions of Rallying, the SA Rally Championship Regulations, these Event Supplementary Regulations and any Bulletins that may be issued. This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with Motorsport Australia OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the Motorsport Australia website at <https://motorsport.org.au/>. Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by Motorsport Australia in relation to the event. Further details can be found in the Motorsport Australia Insurance webpage, available at <https://motorsport.org.au/clubs/insurance>.
- 3.2 Where there is any conflict between the current National Rally Code, the SA Rally Championship Regulations and these Event Supplementary Regulations, these Event Supplementary Regulations will take precedence.
- 3.3 The Motorsport Australia Permit Number authorising the event is **??/?/??/?/??**, which will be displayed on the official notice board at the event.
- 3.4 The length of the rally will be approximately **000**kms, including **00** stages which have a total competitive distance of approximately **000**kms. All special stages are of a gravel/dirt surface, held in the **Council Name** on (closed) public, private roads or crown land.
- 3.5 Any damage caused to public or private property must be reported to the next control official and, at the conclusion of the event, to the Clerk of Course. Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by Motorsport Australia in relation to the Event. Further details can be found on the Motorsport

Crews involved in accidents resulting in property damage are advised that they may be required to pay up to the first \$10,000 of any claim to rectify such property damage. 5.1 Crews shall comprise of two persons only, both being the holders of a current relevant Motorsport Australia licence. One crew member is to be nominated on the entry form as Driver and the other member as Co-Driver.
