Article 3. EVENT DETAILS

3.1 The event type is a ????.

The South Australian Clubman Rally Series (hereafter referred to as the Series) will be held under the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the National Competition Rules of Motorsport Australia, the National Rally Code, Motorsport Australia Rallysprint Standing Regulations, the current South Australian Conditions of Rallying, these Standing Regulations, the Event Supplementary Regulations and any other Further Regulations or Bulletins.

This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with Motorsport Australia OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the Motorsport Australia website at https://motorsport.org.au/.

Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by Motorsport Australia in relation to the event. Further details can be found in the Motorsport Australia Insurance page, available at <u>https://motorsport.org.au/clubs/insurance</u>.

- 3.2 Where there is any conflict between the current National Rally Code, the Rallysprint Standing Regulations, the Series Regulations and these Event Supplementary Regulations, these Event Supplementary Regulations will take precedence.
- 3.3 The Motorsport Australia Permit Number authorising the event is ???/????, which will be displayed on the official notice board at the event.
- 3.4 The length of the rally will be approximately 000kms, including 00 stages which have a total competitive distance of approximately 000kms. All stages are of a gravel/dirt surface, held on closed private roads.

5.1 Crews shall comprise of up to two persons both being the holders of a minimum Motorsport Australia Level 2S licence. The minimum age for drivers and co-drivers in Rally Sprints is 14 years. Please note that Junior Drivers will need an experienced Co-Driver and proof of experience will need approval by the Clerk of course. For Rallysprint events, there must be 2 crew in the vehicle to be eligible for Series points.
